Transportation Fees

- Students who reside less than 2.5 miles from school may purchase bus transportation.
- Annual, per person, fees for this service are \$275 (Family maximum \$400) if paid by July 1st; \$285 (\$410 Family maximum) after July 1st.
- Payments and bus arrangements will be made at the USD #416 Transportation Office (West side of Broadmoor Elementary School), phone (913) 837-1961, and also during August 2, 2018 School Enrollment at Louisburg High School from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Payments can also be mailed to PO Box 940, Louisburg, Kansas 66053. All checks should be payable to USD#416.

Early Childhood Pre-School Fees (Ages 3 and 4 Years Old)

- Preschool – 2 days a week - \$150 per month
- Preschool – 3 days a week - \$200 per month
- Pre-K - \$250 per month
- Materials Fee - \$50
- *Students who have a non-speech IEP are free.*
- *Reduced rates available for students who qualify for free lunch*

Transportation will be provided for students on non-speech IEPs.

For an annual fee, transportation MAY be available for non-IEP students.

An annual decision on space availability will be made by the administration.
