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Dear Parents:

Kansas law requires schools to keep a written plan (care plan) prepared by your child's doctor for

- Managing asthma
- Anaphylaxis episodes (allergic reactions requiring your student to use an Epi-pen)
- Food substitutions
- Diabetes and hypoglycemia
- Seizures

**If your child no longer has the health condition(s), please note it on the form, date and sign it, and return it to the nurse.

A new form must be completed for each new school year. This means we cannot use forms from last year.

- If your child has **asthma** you will need to have your doctor fill out the **Kansas Asthma Action Plan.** (If we do not have an inhaler at school and you cannot be reached, 911 will be called.)
- If your child has **food/insect sting/latex, etc. allergy** and require an epi-pen, your doctor will need to fill out the **Epi-Pen Allergy Action Plan.**
- If your child has a **food allergy** such as nuts and a **substitution** is medically required; your doctor needs to fill out the **Medical Statement for Student Requiring Special Meals Due to Food Allergy or Intolerance** form. The school cannot provide food substitutions unless a doctor's note is on file.
- If your child has **diabetes/ hypoglycemia.** your doctor must provide a written plan for daily care and emergency management.
- If your child has **seizures** you will need to fill out the **School Seizure Plan.**
